Community Announcements

Water Assessment. We have hired an engineer to assess our water system. They will determine if we can issue additional water shares and if our system can handle more shares. They will also assess the new playground lots to see if we can dig a well, if needed, in order to provide water access to all vacant lot owners. We will keep you posted and updated.

Water Inspection Survey. We received our well Department of Health 2018 Survey Inspection Report. There were no significant deficiencies, findings, referrals or observations. However, they did have some recommendations that Jack Smith, our water manager, will research for cost and feasibility.

Financial Records Audit. NW Bookkeeping performed a non-CPA certified audit on our financial records for the last three years. This was requested by the current Treasurer, Kathleen Johnson, to cover the years she has served in this position. We received our records back with the following quote from Cindi Zimmerman's letter, "We reviewed the files for the years 2015-2018 and found no discrepancies.
