Water Assessment. As we mentioned last newsletter, we have hired an engineer to assess our water system. They will determine if we can issue additional water shares and if our system can handle more shares. They will also assess the new playground lots to see if we can dig a well, if needed, in order to provide water access to all vacant lot owners. We have no updates but will keep you posted.

Water Use Efficiency Public Forum/Annual Meeting. Every six years we as a community must establish water use goals. The Department of Health requires us to hold a public forum to establish these goals. We will combine this forum with our annual meeting this year. So mark your calendars for **Friday, June 21, 2019**, for our annual meeting and water use forum to be held at the Cranberry Lake Pavilion.

Our current water use goal is: "Maintain average use per home of 134 gallons per day or less through 2018." Our actual usage per home has been 111 gallons per day (gpd), which is clearly below our goal of 134 gpd.
